تشرف هيئة فولبرايت بالقاهرة أن تتقدم لكم بخالص التحية والتقدير. برجاء التفضل بالإحاطة أن هيئة فولبرايت هي هيئة مصرية أمريكية أسست بناءً على إتفاقية تعاون بين الحكومتين المصرية والأمريكية عام ١٩٤٩. وعلى مدى ما يقرب من سبعين عامًا كرست الهيئة مجهوداتها للتقريب بين البلدين عن طريق التبادل التعليمي والثقافي. وفي هذا الإطار يسرنا أن نعلن عن فتح باب التقديم لبرنامج **Fulbright Junior Faculty Development Program**. يهدف البرنامج إلى تنمية القدرات المهنية لأعضاء هيئة التدريس بالجامعات والمعاهد العليا المصرية المانحة لدرجة البكالوريوس أو الليسانس (مرفق طيه معايير إختيار المتقدمين للمنح) من خلال إتاحة الفرص للحصول على منح لمدة عشرة أسابيع في الفترة من ٣٠ يونيو - ٨ سبتمبر ٢٠٢٠ ببعض الجامعات بالولايات المتحدة الأمريكية، وذلك في إحدى المجالات التالية :

- علوم الطاقة المتجددة و الهندسة (الطاقة الشمسية - طاقة الرياح - الطاقة الكهرومائية - الوقود الحيوي - الطاقة الحرارية الأرضية): الكيمياء، الفيزياء، الرياضيات، الهندسة الكهربائية، الهندسة الميكانيكية، والهندسة الكيميائية، على أن تكون تلك التخصصات تتعلق بشكل مباشر بمجال الطاقة المتجددة (لا تشمل المنح تخصصات هندسة البترول أو الطاقة النووية).
- تكنولوجيا المعلومات: هندسة وتطوير البرمجيات، هندسة الشبكات، الحوسبة عالية الأداء، أمن المعلومات، التقنيات والشبكات اللاسلكية، الأمن الإلكتروني، تكنولوجيا نظم قواعد البيانات، علم المعلومات، والذكاء الاصطناعي (في المجالات المتعلقة بتكنولوجيا المعلومات فقط).

لا تشمل المنح إجراء أي أبحاث فردية.

يستهدف البرنامج:

- أعضاء هيئة التدريس الحاصلين على درجة الماجستير مع خبرة تدريس جامعي لا تقل عن خمس سنوات.
- أعضاء هيئة التدريس طلبة الدكتوراة مع خبرة تدريس جامعي لا تقل عن ثلاث سنوات.
- أعضاء هيئة التدريس الحاصلين على درجة الدكتوراه مع خبرة تدريس الجامعي لا تتعدى خمس سنوات من تاريخ الحصول على درجة الدكتوراه.

والجدير بالذكر أن المنحة تغطي الراتب الشهري وتكلفة السفر إلى ومن الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية ونفقات السفر الإضافية ونفقات التنمية المهنية والإقامة والتأمين الصحي.

مرفق طيه لسيادتكم شرحاً للبرنامج باللغة الإنجليزية وإرشادات التقديم فيه، حيث نرجو أن يتم من قبل سيادتكم الإعلان عن البرنامج في الكليات المختلفة. هذا ويرجى التنبيه أن آخر موعد للتقديم لهذا البرنامج هو ١ ديسمبر ٢٠١٩.

2020 Fulbright Junior Faculty Development Program for Egypt

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The 2020 Fulbright Junior Faculty Development Program will bring young faculty members from Egypt to U.S. institutions for faculty development, mentoring, and cultural exchange activities in the fields of **Renewable Energy and Engineering** and **Information Technology** **from June 30 through September 8, 2020**. During this 10-week program, faculty members will be introduced to new teaching and research methods, observe classes, attend seminars, and develop linkages with American faculty through weekly mentoring sessions. On-going community engagement with university-identified host families, volunteers, or others in the broader local community will facilitate the scholars' participation in outreach activities, including visits to historical sites and attendance at cultural events. While introduction to new research methods in the scholars' disciplines does constitute one component of the Fulbright Junior Faculty Development Program, the program is **not** intended to provide a venue for individual research projects.

The Fulbright Program is sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.

OBJECTIVES:

- Build higher education capacity in Egypt through faculty development and mentoring for junior faculty members.
- Foster long-term collaboration and institutional linkages between Egyptian and U.S. academics.
- Promote mutual understanding between Egyptians and Americans by facilitating the scholars' engagement with the broader host campus community.

Grants are **not** for the principal purpose of:

- Attending conferences
- Completing doctoral dissertations
- Travel and consultation at multiple institutions.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS (Applicants from Egypt can only apply in one of the following fields):

- **Renewable Energy and Engineering (Solar, Wind, Hydro-electric, Biofuel, Geothermal):** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Electrical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering as related specifically to Renewable Energy (does **not** include Petroleum or Nuclear energy/engineering fields).
- **Information Technology:** Software Development and Engineering, Network Engineering, High Performance Computing, Information Security, Wireless Networking and Technologies, Cyber Security, Database Systems Technology, Informatics, and Artificial Intelligence (in fields related to IT only).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Egyptian citizenship; holders of U.S. green cards and/or passports are ineligible. (Must submit scanned copy of original National ID or passport).
- Applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Full-time faculty status at an Egyptian university or other institution of higher learning in Egypt (must be a degree granting institution, offering at least a bachelor's degree).
- MA/MS degree and at least five years of university-level teaching experience, OR a Ph.D. and no more than five years of university-level teaching experience. MA/MS holders who are currently enrolled in a doctoral program must possess at least three years of university-level teaching experience.
- Proficiency in English sufficient to effectively carry out grant activities in the United States. Although a TOEFL score is not required, applicants must possess a strong command of the English language.
- Commitment to classroom teaching and desire to strengthen teaching and leadership skills.
- Scholar's academic focus must be in one of the program's offered academic discipline cohorts.
- Must be available to travel to the United States and participate for the duration of the program from **June 30 – September 8, 2020**.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the assessment and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.

Preference will be given to applicants without significant recent experience in the U.S. and/or overseas.

Important: The Fulbright Junior Faculty Development Program seeks applicants that have developed a sense of personal integrity and are original thinkers. Copying someone else's writing, whether from the Internet, from a book or from a friend is considered **plagiarism**. Any quoted words or sentences should include a citation. An applicant who is found to have plagiarized in any form (including unintentional or accidental plagiarism) in his or her application will be disqualified. All content in applications must be the applicant's original contribution and his/her own intellectual property. Having someone else write or contribute to the writing of an individual's application, either fully or partially, does not uphold the standards of integrity expected of Fulbrighters and may result in the ineligibility of your application.

BENEFITS:

- Administrative stipend.
- Travel allowance and equipment allowance.
- Lodging for program duration.
- Travel and accommodations for a re-entry workshop to be hosted in Washington, D.C.
- Round-trip international travel to the U.S.
- Accident and sickness health benefit coverage for the duration of the program.

Dependents including spouses and children cannot accompany the scholar to the U.S. for this program.
