Communication skills Good communication skills gained through my experience as cardiothoracic surgeon.

Job-related skills

Administrative duties:

These include:

- Selecting patients for admission to the department.
- Discharging patients postoperative for outpatient follow-up.
- Running 2 weekly outpatient clinics.
- Management of chest trauma from admission till discharge.
- Organizing many scientific days discussing the most important thoracic surgery diseases in our community e.g.: -Mesothelioma, bronchogenic carcinoma.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:

My clinical training:-

- Pre-operative preparation of 2 regular lists a week.
- Post operative care (immediate in ICU and late in the ward).
- Perfusionist (warm and cold cardioplegia).

Operative skills: two lists a week each list contains

1) Usually Three or Four cases of thoracic surgery: In my center , we are doing all varieties of thoracic surgery except minimally invasive thoracic surgery (My center is newly starting in VATs). Such as:- Decortication

(Empyema is common here), chest wall tumors, pleural biopsy, lung resections (lobectomy, pneumonectomy), Achalasia, cancer esophagus, mediastinal masses, diaphragmatic hernia, eventration, tracheoesophageal fistula, Bronchoscope .

2) One sometimes two cases open heart surgery most properly mitral valve replacement or aortic valve and double valve replacement, CABG also we operate many cases of congenital heart surgeries with Prof: Adel El-Gamal at Qena university hospital include VSD, ASD, Sub-aortic membrane, double RV chamber, aortic coarctation and Fallot.

I am now performing some thoracic surgeries independently such as: Bronchoscope, esophagoscopy, wedge resection, Decortication, pleural biopsy (through VATs), surgical management of lung abscess, Diaphragmatic hernia and assist in major thoracic surgery procedures such as lobectomy and mediastinal tumors. I also assisted Dr / Hussein El-Khayat (Consultant of Thoracic Surgery in Assuit university hospital) in Uniportal VATS . I also assist my professors in Uniportal VATs in Ain Shams Uni.hospital such as VATs bullectomy , thymectomy and lobectomy.

In cardiac I am independently doing sternotomy, pericardiotomy, saphenous vein harvesting, cannulation, decannulation and sternal closure, and I have assisted in about 30 open heart surgeries as 1st assistant and about 150 surgeries as second assistant. Most of these open-heart surgeries are

valve replacement, CABG (as a second assistant in CABG) and in pediatric cardiac surgery.

In addition, I am responsible for management of chest trauma patients in the ER: fracture ribs (haemo and pneumothorax), flail chest, stab chest and firearm chest. I am managing chest trauma in almost all cases without supervision starting from chest tube to ER thoracotomy for massive hemothorax.

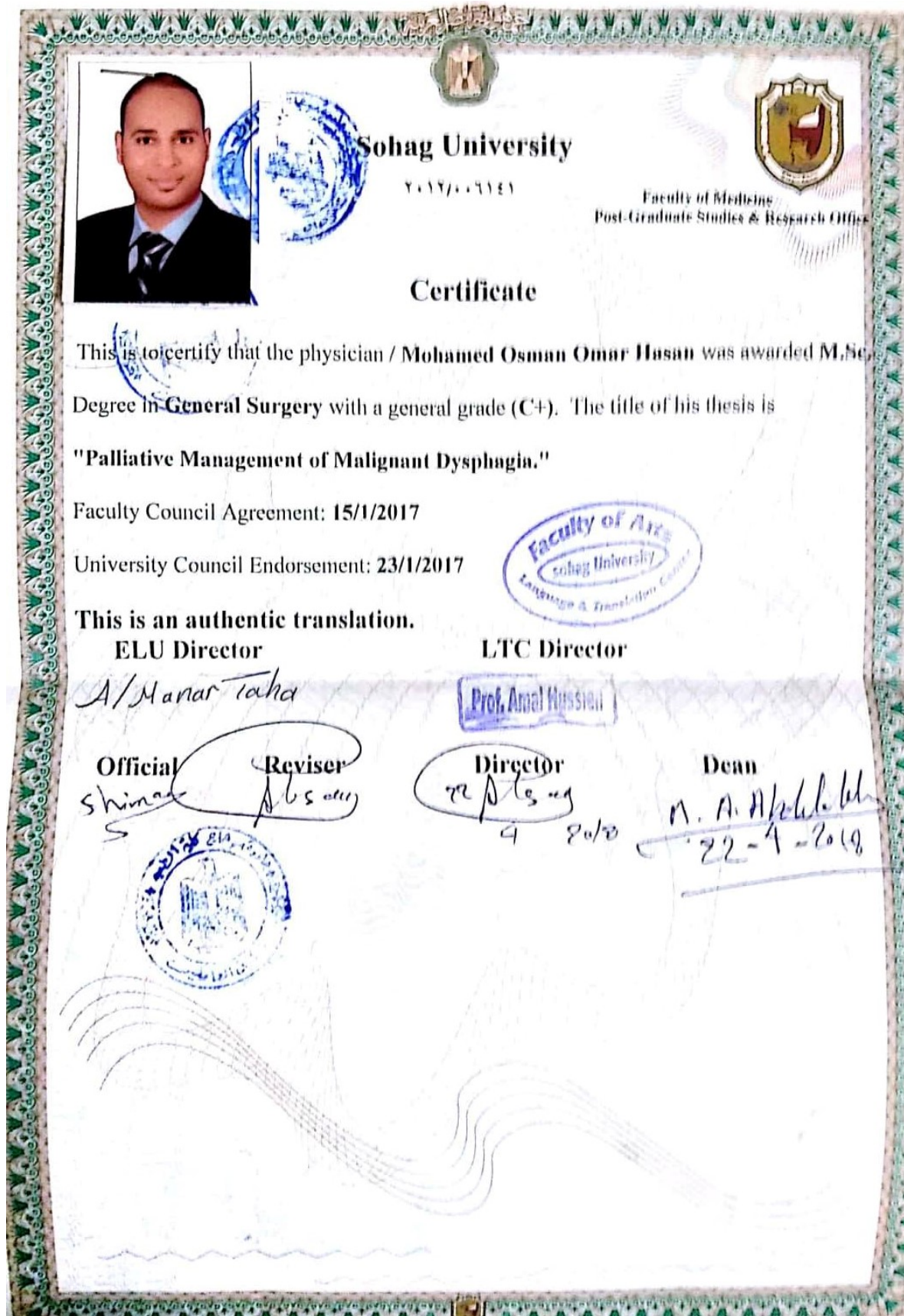
