Communication skills ■ Good communication skills gained through my experience as cardiothoracic surgeon.

Organisational / managerial skills ■ I gained good management skills through my work as an administrative deputy at Qena University Hospital for one year and I was responsible for following up the work of resident doctors and nursing in the internal departments and the emergency department.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:

My clinical training

Pre-operative preparation of 2 regular lists a week.

Postoperative care (immediate in ICU and late in the ward).

Perfusionist (warm and cold cardioplegia).

Operative skills: two lists a week each list contains

1) One sometimes two cases open heart surgery most properly mitral valve replacement or aortic valve and double valve replacement, CABG also we operate many cases of congenital heart surgeries with Prof: Adel Algamal at Qena university hospital include VSD, ASD, Sub-aortic membrane, double RV chamber, aortic coarctation, Glenn shunt, and Fallot.

2) Usually one or two cases thoracic surgery: Decortication (Empyema is common here), chest wall tumors, pleural biopsy, lung resections (lobectomy, pneumonectomy), Achalasia, cancer esophagus, mediastinal masses, diaphragmatic hernia, eventration, tracheoesophageal fistula, Bronchoscope and Thoracoscope.

I am now performing some thoracic surgeries independently such as Bronchoscope, esophagoscope, wedge resection, Decortication, a pleural biopsy (Thoracoscopically), surgical management of lung abscess, Diaphragmatic hernia and Eventration and assist in major thoracic surgery procedures such as lobectomy and mediastinal tumors.

In cardiac surgery, I am independently doing sternotomy, pericardiotomy, saphenous vein harvesting, cannulation, decannulation and sternal closure, and I have assisted in about 120 open heart surgeries as a 1st assistant and about 240 surgeries as the second assistant. Most of these open heart surgeries are valve replacement, CABG(as a second assistant in CABG) and in pediatric cardiac surgery.

In addition, I am responsible for the management of chest trauma patients in the ER: fracture ribs (haemo and pneumothorax), flail chest, stab chest and firearm chest. I am managing chest trauma in almost all cases without supervision starting from chest tube to ER thoracotomy for massive haemothorax.

I have also a very good experience in rigid bronchoscopy procedures either diagnostic Broncho-alveolar lavage or biopsy or foreign body extraction. I am doing almost one bronchoscope daily for extraction of foreign body inhalation without supervision.

Also, I had assisted Deutch Cardiothoracic Surgery Team in oct 2015 for 7 days we operate 9 patients include 5 cases of CABG and 4 cases of Valve Surgeries Then in Nov 2016 also I had assisted Deutch Cardiothoracic Surgery team Also, in Oct I had assisted Deutch Cardiothoracic Surgery team 2017.

Also, I had assisted prof Dr. Patric Ruchate professor of cardiovascular surgery in Lussanne university hospital, Switzerland during his visit and workshops in our department in Feb 2012.

Also, I had assisted prof Adel Algamal professor of pediatric cardiac surgery, Mansoura university hospital for 3 years at Qena university hospital. We operate 5: 7 cases every visit that includes VSD, ASD, Glenn shunt, subaortic membrane, DCRV, Fallot tetralogy, pulmonary stenosis and bicuspid aortic valve.
